Student Agreement

Peekskill Clay Studios (PCS)

Located in the heart of New York's Hudson Valley, the Peekskill Clay Studios (PCS) offers a full range of adult and children's classes from pottery to hand building. Membership space is also available for experienced clay artists.

Equipment:

PCS provides basic tools and equipment for the ceramic process. During open workshop hours all common area equipment, wheels, slab roller, etc., are available on a first come first served basis to both members and students. Private tools left in the common area will be made available to all members and students.

Clay:

The PCS uses cone 6 to 10 Stoneware & Porcelain clay.

Students may only use clay provided by the PCS.

Work made outside the PCS or unusual clays or additives used for decoration may not be fired in our kilns.

At this time there is no low firing clay permitted in the studio.

Kilns: Electric & Gas.

(Please refer to separate kiln memo for firing fees and additional policies.) Only PCS Staff and "members with firing privileges" may load and fire kilns. Work should be placed on the appropriate bisque or glaze shelf and full payment must be made and deposited in student drop box prior to firing. Each student is also required to fill out a firing sheet located next to the student drop box.

Glaze Lab:

Students must receive instruction before using glazes.

Pugmill:

Only PCS staff may use the Pugmill.

Keeping it clean!

Members and students are responsible for cleaning up after themselves. Dust is a potential health hazard and must be wiped up with a wet rag or mop. Sanding dry clay in the studio is prohibited but may be done outside or in the spray booth when made available.

Student Workshop Hours:

In addition to classes, students have three hours a week of scheduled open studio hours. Although this session is monitored, no instruction will take place.

Pets:

Sorry no pets!! We love them too but not in the studio.

Smoking:

Smoking is not allowed anywhere within the Clay Studio.

Personal Risk:

Students understand and agree that the Peekskill Clay Studios is not financially responsible or liable for any injuries that may occur on the premises of the PCS or Hat Factory property.

Damaged Work:

Unfortunately damage and loss is part of the ceramic process. The PCS will not issue refund's, discounts or reimbursements for any damage caused by either students, members or staff. This includes firing mishaps.

Cancellation of Classes:

In the event the PCS must cancel a class, we will refund tuition on a prorated basis.
